

# HISTORY OF BELFAIR

William Telfair of Savannah, who married Betsey Bellinger, established Belfair in 1811. They took the first part of "Bellinger" and the last of "Telfair" to name their new plantation Belfair. Belfair was originally a country estate and working plantation devoted to agriculture. In the 1920's Belfair's new owner, William Mosely Swain, planted the oaks that now constitute the magnificent Avenue of the Oaks. Belfair Plantation, L.L.C., the developer of Belfair, purchased the property in September 1994.

Belfair today is a private golfing community that consists of 578 completed homes and a maximum membership of 695.

Approximately 1,100 acres in size, Belfair is located on the mainland in Bluffton, SC five miles from Hilton Head Island, SC on Highway 278. Its waterfront side faces the marshes of the Colleton River. Belfair is 25 miles north of Savannah, GA, 32 miles south of Beaufort, SC, and 110 miles south of Charleston, SC.

Along with the magnificent half-mile oak-lined drive, Belfair is home to both prehistoric and historic sites, dramatic marsh and river views, secluded wetlands and Hidden lake, a 42 acre freshwater chain of lakes.

The upper portion of Hidden Lake contains what has been classified by the US Fish and Wildlife Service as one of the more significant colonial wading bird rookeries in South Carolina. The rookery has been preserved as a conservancy, demonstrating the developer's commitment to preserving the ecological integrity of the land.

Other wildlife found at Belfair include the great blue heron, great egret, snowy egret, green backed heron, the endangered wood stork, bald eagle, wild turkey and the fox. Belfair members enjoy the diverse natural beauty and wildlife with nature trails and designated wildlife viewing areas.

# **BELFAIR DRESS CODE**

# **CLUBHOUSE ATTIRE**

a) Members shall dress in a manner befitting the surroundings, atmosphere, and specific occasion.

b) Pants, Bermuda length shorts and collared shirts, to include mock turtle neck and dress collarless shirts, are acceptable attire in the formal dining room and grillroom. Jackets may be required for certain events. Ladies should dress in a similarly appropriate manner.

c) Cargo pants are allowed in the clubhouse only if the patch pocket lies flat inside the garment. All beach and swim wear, including bathing suits, cover-ups, and tank tops, are prohibited in the clubhouse.

d) Denim Policy Belfair Rules & Regulations

- i) Pants, shorts, shirts or skirts made of any color denim cloth must be in excellent condition, clean, consistent in color, without holes, handwritten messages, rips or tears.
- ii) All denim attire is to be worn in a tasteful manner.
- iii) No low-rise pants (baring midriff), excessively large, baggy denim, bib overalls, painter's pants, cargo pants, cut offs, frayed or low-slung denim is permitted in the clubhouse.
- iv) Denim is never allowed on the golf course, practice range and learning center.
- v) Denim will be allowed at Belfair, including the Clubhouse, Fitness Center and Pool Area (unless, management informs members to the contrary due to a special situation). Denim is not permitted in the Oaks Dining Room. (Unless management specifies that there is a special occasion or event where denim would be allowed.)
- vi) The rules of enforcement for denim reflect the new dress code that has just been issued.
- e) Tee shirts and shorts more than four inches above the knee are not acceptable attire in the dining rooms.
- f) Men may not wear golf hats or visors in the clubhouse, except for the pro shop.
- g) Children over six (6) years of age shall be required to comply with the guidelines of attire.
- h) Members will be responsible for ensuring that their guests are appropriately dressed.

i) In the event management deems a Member's dress to be inappropriate, the Member shall be asked to change to appropriate clothing or to leave the facility.

j) Guests who are not dressed in accordance with these Rules and Regulations shall be treated in the same manner as Members.

k) Changing apparel or shoes is limited to the locker rooms.

# **GOLF COURSE, PRACTICE FACILITIES & LEARNING CENTER**

This dress code is mandatory for all players at all golf facilities, including the practice range and Learning Center. Improperly dressed golfers will be asked to change before using any of the Club's facilities. If in doubt concerning attire, please check with the Golf Shop. Belfair Members are responsible for communicating the dress code to their Guest(s).

MEN

a) Shirts must have both a golf collar and sleeves. Mock or turtleneck collars, both long and short sleeve, are acceptable golf collars.

b) Slacks or Bermuda-length shorts are considered appropriate attire.

c) Tank tops, T-shirts, cut-offs, blue-jeans, cargo pants/shorts with zippered or buttoned exterior pockets, and denim of any color are not permitted.

d) Shirts must be tucked in at all times.

# WOMEN

- a) Dresses, skirts and mid-length shorts (just above the knee) are considered appropriate attire.
- b) Shirts must have a collar or turtleneck. Sleeveless shirts are permitted so long as they have a collar or turtleneck. Halter tops, tank tops, screen printed t-shirts are not permitted.
- c) Blue-jeans, cargo pants/shorts with zippered or buttoned exterior pockets, and denim of any color are not permitted.

# **SPORT & LIFESTYLE CAMPUS ATTIRE**

a) While the Bistro is a laid-back casual atmosphere, shirts or coverups along with shorts and shoes (flip and sandals are acceptable) are to be worn both inside and out.

b) Appropriate swimwear is to be worn at the pool and related facilities. Thongs or revealing swimwear is not acceptable.

# ATTIRE ON PROPERTY


a) Shirts must be worn by Members and those they employ when doing yard work or other forms of home maintenance on any Lot.
